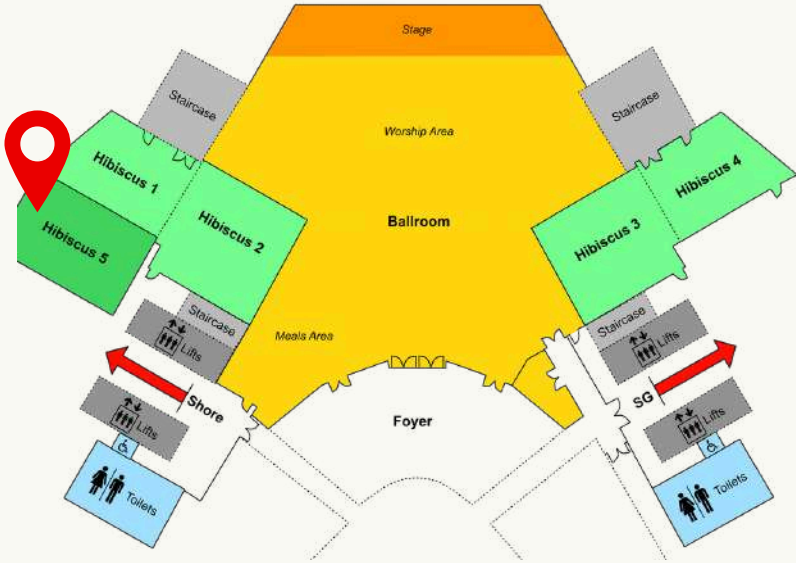

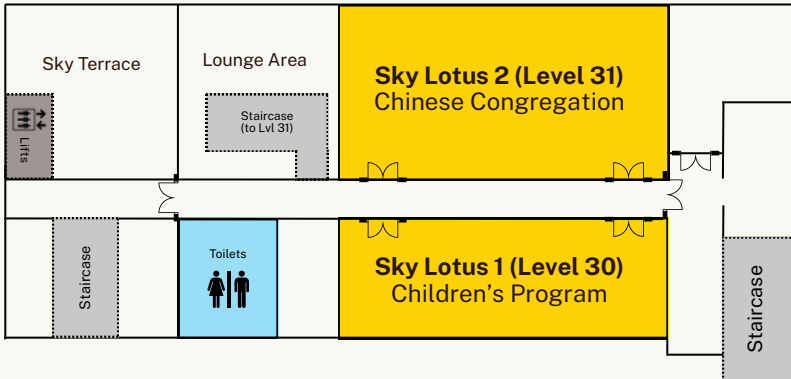

Day 2 | Devotion : Identity in Christ

“Whose Are You?”

Read Scripture: John 1:12; Isaiah 43:1-3

The Bible tells us that when we are saved, we become children of God. That is our new identity in Christ. But what does that mean? First, it means we are loved for who we are, not what we can do or perform. Sometimes our identity gets locked up in our job designation or a role we felt we need to live up to, but God simply loves us as His beloved child - we do not need to earn His love.

Secondly, it means we belong to someone. Very often, we asked the question, "Who am I?" as we searched for the answer to our identity. However, we often forget to ask the next question of "Whose am I?"

Our identity tells us who we belong to. In Isaiah 43:1, God declared "*you are mine*". You belong to the all loving almighty God! He will be with you always and will watch over you because you belong to Him. No matter what happens, and what storms of life may come, He will never let you go thru it alone. For He embraces us in our fears and protects us fiercely for we belonged to Him.

I pause now to enter into a time of reflection:

- What does it mean to you to know you belong to God?
- How will you respond to life's challenges with this assurance of belonging to God?

Till Christ is Formed in Us

Read Scripture: John 14 & 15; Gal 4:19

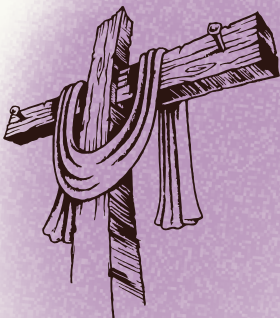
The Gospel of John teaches clearly that Jesus is the way, truth and life (Jn 14:6), the True Vine (Jn 15:1) where His life and mission courses through us. John emphasizes that eternal and genuine spiritual life cannot exist apart from a living union with Jesus Christ. This abiding relationship is established by the Holy Spirit (Jn 14:15-17) who acts as the divine agent bringing believers into union with Jesus, the Source of our spiritual life.

If this is true, why do we sometimes feel spiritually disconnected and defeated?

Imagine your life is like a car.

For many of us, when we first encounter Jesus, we invite Him in — but only as a passenger. We're glad to have Him in our lives, maybe even listening to His advice like the GoogleMaps Navigator. We still want to be the one behind the wheel, choosing the speed, the route, and the destination.

But true spirituality in Christ — real transformation — doesn't happen while we stay in control. Christ doesn't just want a seat in our lives — He wants the driver's seat. Why? Because His goal isn't just to improve our journey — His goal is to form His very life within us.



Day 3 | Devotion : Spirituality in Christ

Paul says in Galatians 4:19, *“I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you.”* That kind of formation doesn’t happen with Jesus merely advising us - it happens when we surrender the wheel and driver seat completely.

Jesus chooses the direction. He sets the pace. And sometimes — let’s be honest — He even takes us through uncomfortable terrain and journeys. It’s all so that we may be conformed to His image.

I pause now for a time of reflection.

- What areas am I struggling to surrender control to Jesus?
- What does “abiding in Christ” look like for me in this season?

Am I buried under chronic busyness and the constant need to produce that I have not given time to be still and silent before God?

I stop what I’m doing to pause, relax my shoulders, open my palms and heart to listen and discern what the Holy Spirit is saying to me.

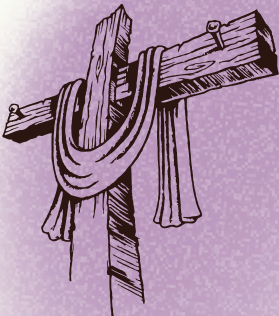
