

TRUST IN GOD

Scripture Text: Genesis 13



Summary Statement:

We trust in God's authority, even when clarity is absent, wisdom feels distant, or reality falls short of His promises, knowing He is faithful and sovereign!

1. Complete authority over our lives

- I. Lot was ungrateful, selfish & worldly (Genesis 13:11,12)
- II. "Salvation involves the reoccupation by God of a guilty sinner in such a way that Jesus Christ has the unchallenged, absolute, perpetual right to dictate the terms whereby that individual henceforth will run his life." (lan Thomas)

2. Trust vs clarity, understanding, or wisdom in your life

- I. Season of Lack vs Season of Plenty FAITH (Genesis 12:10-20, 13:5-13)
 - i. 'It is hard for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of heaven.' (Matthew 19:23-24, Mark 10:23-25)
 - ii. Trust not in our understanding, heart, or capabilities (Proverbs 3:5, Jeremiah 17:9, Psalm 20:7)
 - iii. Show of Deference (Luke 22:42)

3. Even when your present reality does not match His promises

- I. Reaffirmation of God's promise worldly (Genesis 13:14-17)
- II. 'What's so promising about the promised land?'

Sermon Discussion Questions for Missional Cells

- 1. In what area of your life do you feel the pull of worldly influences the most? How do you navigate the tension between worldly values and godly values? What practices help you stay grounded in God?
- 2. Does Christ have 'the unchallenged, absolute, perpetual right to dictate the terms' of your life? If not, what is one specific area you sense God calling you to surrender to Him completely? What makes it challenging to fully surrender that area? What might life look like if you let Christ lead completely?
- 3. Do you find it easier to trust God in seasons of plenty or in seasons of lack? Why? Can you share a personal story that illustrates this?
- 4. What does showing deference to God look like in your life? Are there areas where you've resisted deferring to Him, and how might you take a step toward surrender? What does deference mean practically (e.g., in decisions, relationships, career)? How has showing deference to God shaped your life so far?
- 5. Have you ever faced a situation where your current reality seemed completely at odds with God's promises? How did you respond, and what did you learn from that experience? What Scripture or truths about God sustained you during that time? How can these experiences strengthen your faith moving forward?






